Father Gilbert Enderle is a Redemptorist Missionary who recently served at the Blessed Seelos Center in New Orleans, LA, as the Vice-Postulator of the (Sainthood) Cause of Redemptorist Father (Blessed) Francis Xavier Seelos. Generally known as "Fr. Gil", he is a native of San Antonio, Texas, the descendant of a German-Alsatian ancestors who first came to Texas in the 1840s. He is the youngest born to a family of six.

In the first part of his life, he and his family were members of the Redemptorist Parish of St. Gerard Majella in east San Antonio. Fr. Gil joined the Redemptorists as a seminarian and he was an active catechist of children in the Spanish-speaking migrant worker camps in Wisconsin, and later after being ordained a priest in December 1962, he taught some 32 years in both the U.S.A. and later in the 1980s & 1990s in the West African country of Nigeria. He received his doctorate in Historical Theology from St. Louis University. And, later in 2005 through 2013, Fr. Gil was stationed at the Redemptorist Worldwide Headquarters in Rome, Italy, as an author and editor within the Redemptorist Historical Institute. He has worn many hats over the years. Besides his ministry in (English and Spanish-speaking) parishes, he also had experience in Worldwide Marriage Encounter, in conducting spiritual retreats, and missions for laity, religious, and promotional work for the Redemptorists' *Liguori Publications*. He has served our community and parish for nearly 10 years and he has done so with a smile and a kind heart.

In the Redemptorist Community, Fr. Gil's knowledge of history and his many family stories always make for interesting conversations at the dinner table. And, he loves to work on carpentry projects, and he has restored many pieces of furniture. He can also be seen tinkering in his wood shed, when he is not visiting a sick person or child, or celebrating a Mass. Also, Fr. Gil could be seen cutting Forres's and Fr. Gerry LaPorte's hair. He will join Fr. LaPorte once again, at his new home.

While we are all sad to see him depart New Orleans, we also know that New Orleans and the Blessed Seelos Shrine is a richer place because of his many years of humble service to the people living in our community. We wish to thank him for all he has done to bring happiness to our hearts and for shepherding us closer to Christ our Redeemer.

Save St. Mary's Assumption Church Restoration Capital Campaign

St. Mary's is one of the most beautiful and historic churches in New Orleans. It is also the final resting placed of Blessed Francis Seelos, a Redemptorist priest who ministered to his parish, especially those who were sick and dying of the yellow fever epidemic. Because of heroic care for others, he contracted the illness himself and died of it. His selfless dedication has placed him on the path to sainthood in the Catholic Church.

After 164 years of age and climate — which is hot, humid, and vulnerable to hurricanes — have taken a toll on St. Mary's. As a result, the church has sustained serious damage to the interior plaster walls and ceiling.

As stewards of this treasure and being deeply devoted to the legacy of Blessed Francis Seelos, the Redemptorists of the parish are raising the necessary funds to preserve this beautiful church. Their "Save St. Mary's Campaign Committee" is organizing and directing efforts to restore St. Mary's to its original beauty, while fortifying the structure for future generations.
