

LETTER FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

May the joy of the risen Lord fill your hearts and your day!

Last week we celebrated Holy Week. We made the journey together proceeding into Jerusalem with Christ on Palm Sunday and then, awaiting the Sacred Triduum. We joined with the apostles and Jesus at His Last Supper and we had our feet washed by Him, and then reciprocated His act of service by washing the feet of each other. We also kept watch with Jesus in the Garden – maybe even dozing off a little like the apostles – and then, we followed discreetly behind as He was taken to judgement and condemnation. We travelled the Via Sacra – the Way of the Cross – cringing when Jesus fell, crying with the women of Jerusalem, parting with His mother Mary, nailing Him to the cross, and finally, placing Him in the tomb. We waited knowing, but maybe not completely sure and understanding His resurrection, then proclaiming it loud and clear for all to hear at the Easter Vigil, and again on Easter Sunday.

Our Easter joy and happiness continues. This weekend we celebrate God's Divine Mercy. Jesus lives and He wants us to live full and wonderful lives. God wants us to bask in His love, and forgiveness, by forgiving each other and asking for forgiveness of our sins. God wants to bathe us in His mercy, by pouring the light of His love directly into our hearts. We ask God to illuminate us and guide us to share His mercy and love with others – family, friends, and even those whom we don't yet know.

The next few weeks, we continue this journey of faith, praising God and remembering the resurrected Jesus and celebrating His love for us. May this Easter season be a time of great love and renewed faithfulness for you, your family, and our parish.

Save St. Mary's Assumption Church Restoration Capital Campaign


St. Mary's is one of the most beautiful and historic churches in New Orleans. It is also the final resting placed of Blessed Francis Seelos, a Redemptorist priest who ministered to his parish, especially those who were sick and dying of the yellow fever epidemic. Because of heroic care for others, he contracted the illness himself and died of it. His selfless dedication has placed him on the path to sainthood in the Catholic Church.

After 164 years of age and climate — which is hot, humid, and vulnerable to hurricanes — have taken a toll on St. Mary's. As a result, the church has sustained serious damage to the interior plaster walls and ceiling.

As stewards of this treasure and being deeply devoted to the legacy of Blessed Francis Seelos, the Redemptorists of the parish are raising the necessary funds to preserve this beautiful church.
