





Unveiling of new Painting at St. Mary's Chapel!

A new artwork honoring Blessed Father Francis Seelos — who gave his life serving yellow fever victims of New Orleans was unveiled and blessed on Saturday,
October 4th at St. Mary's Chapel.



The beautiful new artwork, entitled "Father Francis Seelos Ministering to Yellow Fever Victims" by renown local artist, George Schmidt was commissioned in memory of Louise Maehr Martin (1947-2018) by her family and friends in appreciation of her leadership of the campaign to relocate and restore the original 1844 Saint Mary's Chapel and re-establish it in 1997 as a place of worship within Saint Alphonsus Parish.

We are making progress on the exterior renovations! Save St. Mary's Assumption Church Restoration Capital Campaign

St. Mary's is one of the most beautiful and historic churches in New Orleans. It is also the final resting placed of Blessed Francis Seelos, a Redemptorist priest who ministered to his parish, especially those who were sick and dying of the yellow fever epidemic. Because of heroic care for others, he contracted the illness himself and died of it. His selfless dedication has placed him on the path to sainthood in the Catholic Church.

After 164 years of age and climate — which is hot, humid, and vulnerable to hurricanes — have taken a toll on St. Mary's. As a result, the church has sustained serious damage to the interior plaster walls and ceiling.

As stewards of this treasure and being deeply devoted to the legacy of Blessed Francis Seelos, the Redemptorists of the parish are raising the necessary funds to preserve this beautiful church. Their "Save St. Mary's Campaign Committee" is organizing and directing efforts to restore St. Mary's to its original beauty, while fortifying the structure for future generations.
