The front of the Church is looking like new again! Save St. Mary's Assumption Church Restoration Capital Campaign

St. Mary's is one of the most beautiful and historic churches in New Orleans. It is also the final resting placed of Blessed Francis Seelos, a Redemptorist priest who ministered to his parish, especially those who were sick and dying of the yellow fever epidemic. Because of heroic care for others, he contracted the illness himself and died of it. His selfless dedication has placed him on the path to sainthood in the Catholic Church.

After 164 years of age and climate — which is hot, humid, and vulnerable to hurricanes — have taken a toll on St. Mary's. As a result, the church has sustained serious damage to the interior plaster walls and ceiling.

As stewards of this treasure and being deeply devoted to the legacy of Blessed Francis Seelos, the Redemptorists of the parish are raising the necessary funds to preserve this beautiful church. Their "Save St. Mary's Campaign Committee" is organizing and directing efforts to restore St. Mary's to its original beauty, while fortifying the structure for future generations. 

MEET A REDEMPTORIST

Redemptorist Bishop Jon Hansen, C.Ss.R., while working with the Indigenous people at St. Mary's Parish in Saskatoon, felt called to work with First Nations people in Canada – particularly with those of the North. He was privileged to serve as a Pastor of Our Lady of Victory Parish – the iconic "igloo church" - in Inuvik in 2015. "The people of the North, particularly the Indigenous people, are very spiritual eyewitnesses of God working in their lives in concrete ways," he said. "When I am in a period of doubt or spiritual dryness,

I only have to visit some of the elders in our communities to be reminded that God is here, that God is present, and that God is at work even in the most difficult situations. Never doubt that God is at work in our lives."


